Who Can Help?

Families with

- *At least 2 members with epilepsy, at least one with LGS
- *LGS as a primary diagnosis
- *Epilepsy or LGS must **not** be due to trauma, tumors, CNS infection, stroke, pregnancy or birth complications or other environmental factors
- *For LGS family member
 - seizure onset between 2 to 6 yrs.
 - previous typical development before seizure onset
 - must not evolve from infantile spasms

Participating in Research

At no cost to you, includes

- *filling out a medical questionnaire, a consent form, and release of medical records form
- *donating DNA: saliva or blood for genetic analysis
- *genetic analysis, with positive results reported to your doctor upon your request
